Puppies should be vaccinated with DA2PP every 3-4 weeks, until they reach **at least 16 weeks old**. Dogs over 16 weeks old getting vaccinations for the first time need two sets given 3-4 weeks apart. Bordetella is given annually.

Kittens should be vaccinated with FVRCP every 3-4 weeks, until they reach **at least 16 weeks old**. Cats over 16 weeks old getting vaccinations for the first time need two sets given 3-4 weeks apart.

**ALL** cats under one year old should receive two Leukemia vaccinations 3-4 weeks apart and then every other year for cats with a high risk of exposure (typically cats who spend time outdoors).

Listed vaccination prices do not include follow-up boosters.

## Dog Spay/Neuter Surgery \$ 300

Surgeries are done by appointment only. Before scheduling an appointment, cats and dogs must be at least 16 weeks of age and completely current on all required vaccinations. There may be additional fees for surgical complications (such as retained testicles, in heat, infections, pregnancies, etc.). We reserve the right to refuse service for any animal in which surgery is deemed a health risk. Additional charges apply for elective services (such as hernia repairs, baby tooth extractions, nail trimming, etc.).
