### DOG VACCINES

Rabies	\$25
DA2PP	\$45
<small>(Distemper/Adenovirus/Parvo/Parainfluenza)</small>	
Bordetella	\$45
Leptospirosis	\$45
Lyme Disease	\$45
Influenza	\$45

Puppies should be vaccinated with DA2PP every 3-4 weeks, starting at 8 weeks, until they reach at least 16 weeks old. Dogs over 16 weeks old getting vaccinations for the first time need two sets given 3-4 weeks apart. Bordetella is given annually.

### CAT VACCINES

Rabies	\$25
FVRCP	\$45
<small>(Rhinitis/Tracheitis/Panleukopenia/Chlamydia/Calicivirus)</small>	
Leukemia	\$45

Kittens should be vaccinated with FVRCP every 3-4 weeks, starting at 8 weeks, until they reach at least 16 weeks old. Cats over 16 weeks old getting vaccinations for the first time need two sets given 3-4 weeks apart. ALL cats under one year old should receive two Leukemia vaccinations 3-4 weeks apart and then every other year for cats with a high risk of exposure (typically cats who spend time outdoors).

Surgeries are done by appointment only. Before scheduling an appointment, dogs and cats must be at least 16 weeks old, in good health, and be fully vaccinated before surgery.

Rabbits must be at least 6 months old and in good health before surgery. There may be additional fees for surgical complications such as retained testicles, being in heat or pregnant at time of spay, infections, hernia repairs, etc.
